The Class of 2011 produced another fine set of results. The overall pass rate was 99,4%, with one unfortunate narrowly missing a pass. We hope he will pass his supplementary exam and thereby give us a 100% pass.

The 148 boys achieved a total of 238 A symbols, with a Matric Exemption rate of 85%, 5% higher than last year.

The release of the 2011 Grade 12 results was met with excitement as two of our learners were acknowledged for their academic excellence at a special function hosted at the Durban International Convention Centre. Durban High School's Kashmeel Bisseru and Thaahir Mathir occupied two of the top five positions in the Umlazi district.
